**Folder structure**

The folder named “Data” should contain three raw datasets “Liberia\_clean.dta”, “Niger\_clean.dta”, and “Senegal\_clean.dta”.

The folder named “Output” is a placeholder for the results.

The folder named “Code” contains all required do files to replicate all tables and figures in the paper. The steps to replicate the paper are:

- Open the file “00\_MasterDo.do” and add your personal path to wherever the reproducibility package is saved.
- Run the master do file. Running this file will run all other do files in this folder, thereby creating all tables and figures in the paper.
  - o The first file it runs is 01\_CreateDataset, which is a file that takes the raw datasets and creates a dataset that is subsequently used in all analyses.

- Each subsequent file do file is labelled XX\_TY\_ShortDescription or XX\_FY\_ShortDescription, where XX is the number of the do file (in chronological order in which they appear in the paper from page 25 onwards), TY or FY refers to Table Y or Figure Y in the paper, and “ShortDescription” is a short description of the paper.
- Each do file creates one table or (part of a) figure. The outputs, stored in the folder “Output” are named equivalently to the do files.
- The master do file reproduces all tables and figures with two exceptions:
  - Table A1 is manually created.
  - Each regression table in the paper contains the mean of the outcome variable. This mean is calculated in the respective do files, but is not automatically added into the tables.
