India's long-term poverty trend, 2011-12 to 2023-24

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This review verifies the reproducibility of the exhibits included in the paper "*India's long-term poverty trend, 2011-12 to 2023-24*".

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Main findings

- **Every exhibit of the paper has been reproduced accurately.**
- The code was successfully executed on a new computer after:
 1. Updating the working directory in line 19 of the do-file "oo_master.do", and running it.
- The output demonstrates consistent stability across multiple runs. Specifically, executing the code two times consecutively yielded identical results.
- The code takes approximately 1 hour to run.
- We conducted our reproducibility analysis based on the paper shared by the authors.
- **Verification Process and Data Handling:**
 - The reproducibility package relies on 2 types of data: open, and accessible (public but not included in the reproducibility package)
 - Open data is included in the public reproducibility package.
 - Reviewers used accessible data provided directly by the authors to conduct the reproducibility verification, and this is not included in the public reproducibility package.
 - Reviewers verified that the accessible data matches what was provided by the authors; results of this verification are documented in the file *comparison_report.csv*.
 - *data_hash_report.csv* lists the SHA256 hashes of all files in the Data folder to support data integrity checks. Users who acquire the forthcoming/accessible/limited-access/restricted data can use this file to verify that the data has not been altered.
- **Reproducibility Summary:**

- **Data:** All data sources are publicly available and included in the reproducibility package.
- **Code:** All code files (from cleaning to analysis) are included in the reproducibility package.
- **Outputs:** All outputs are generated by code included in the reproducibility package.
- **Dependencies environment:** The reviewers created a new environment using the latest versions of dependencies available at the moment of the review.
