Memory and Runtime Requirements

• The code was last run on a Windows 10 laptop with 16GB of RAM.

• Stata analysis code takes approximately 20 minutes to run.

#### **Instructions to Replicators**

The code to reproduce the results included in the working paper. To recreate the outputs, follow the steps below.

- 1. Download the reproducibility package on your computer.
- 2. Open the downloaded folder.
  - A. Download the "Template" folder and save it.
  - B. The data used for this paper is available in the "Stata" folder under two subfolders namely;
    - i) sub-folder "rawdata"
    - ii) sub-folder "output" which contains all the outputs and results of the code, all the processed final dataset of CEQ income concepts. It also contains another sub-folder "Temp". Temp contains the temporary datasets generated using do files and codes.
    - sub-folder additional documentation, containing multiple files which will aid with the understanding of this reproducibility package. For instance, "macro-fiscal administrative data" which contains the relevant administrative data to finalize the model and macro validate the results
  - C. Download all above three folders and copy all the files
  - D. All the codes are the in folder "do-files". First file is called 00\_PSE\_master: in Stata.
    - i. To run the Stata MASTER, open it and edit the path of the repository copy in your computer. This do-file creates all the non-map tables and graphs included in the working paper.
    - ii. All the user written packages are installed in the ado folder of the package.
    - iii. All interventions' results are produced by running the do files no. 01 to 12.
    - iv. The do file 99\_PSE\_CEQ income concepts would produce the outputs and 999 do file would produce the FIA results.
    - v. The do file 101\_PSE\_etabs produces would produce all the e-sheets (e tabs) or MWBs using the templates already shared.
    - vi. The do file 103. PSE\_graphs\_report produces all the graphs used in the report. The graphs are separately saved in the folder "Output" under subfolder "graphs"
  - E. Additional calculations are required for the following outputs:
    - i. Table 4-2: The calculation is explained in section 4.5.1 of the report, and it uses the price of electricity given in Table 2-4 on page 16 of the report.
    - ii. Table 9-1: Column "PECS 2016/17" is the result of the code output exported in "c1" sheet of the excel file c1.xlsx. The calculation of the rest

- of the columns are done in excel sheet "Macrovalidation". The results are not reproducible if this excel file is deleted.
- iii. Figure A.2: The first 5 columns are exported via code to the excel file pdi\_pgt.xlsx. Average income is calculated by dividing the total income by column 2, and average contributions are calculated by dividing the total contributions by column 3.
- iv. Table C.1: The table is exported via code to the excel file AnnexC.xlsx (Columns F-N).
