Main findings

- The code was successfully executed on a new computer after:
 1. Changing the paths.
- The output demonstrates consistent stability across multiple runs. Specifically, executing the code two times consecutively yielded identical results.
- The code takes approximately 40 minutes to run.
- Every exhibit in the paper was reproduced.

Reproducibility assessment

- Paper exhibits were attempted to be reproduced in a computer with the following specifications:
 - OS: Windows 11 Enterprise
 - Processor: Intel(R) Core(TM) i5-1145G7 CPU @ 2.60GHz
 - Memory available: 15.7 GB
 - Software version: Stata version 18
- We conducted our reproducibility analysis based on the paper sent by the authors on March 1st.
- **Reproducibility Summary:**
 - **Data:** Some data is confidential and not included in the package (details provided in README).

- **Code:** The package contains all necessary code files. Verification processes are initiated from intermediate data stages rather than raw data. While the package includes scripts for cleaning raw data, these scripts were not executed by the reproducibility team, as the files containing the complete dataset with all observations were not shareable.
- **Outputs:** All outputs are generated by code included in the reproducibility package.
- **Reproducibility verification:** Not all of the data used to conduct this verification is included in the public package.
