

Readme file on Reproducibility: Direct and Indirect Effects of Subsidized Dual Apprenticeships

July 30, 2024

Overview

This document addresses the reproducibility of the paper "Direct and Indirect Effects of Subsidized Dual Apprenticeships". The following information addresses the aspects needed to run the code and data used for this publication.

What the package contains

The package folder, named **Reproducibility package** has the following items.

- The paper of the publication
- A folder, named *Raw datasets*, where the user will deposit the datasets used in this study, available in the World Bank Microdata Library and Enterprise Survey data portal.
- A folder, named *Paper 2nd follow-up* that contains the code and outputs produced for the paper.
- A folder named *Overleaf* that contains the latex file that compiles all figures and tables in Overleaf.

Computational requirements for the package

Paper exhibits were reproduced in a computer with the following specifications:

- OS: Windows 10 Enterprise, version 21H2
- Processor: Intel(R) Xeon(R) Gold 6226R CPU @ 2.90GHz, 16 Core(s)
- Memory available: 32 GB

- Software version: Stata 18 Running the code takes approximately 5 hours runtime.

Stata packages used

The packages used for this publication are the following: *outtable*, *ietoolkit*, *estout*, *rwolf2*, *kdens*, *mhtreg*, *pdslasso*, *qqvalue*, *texdoc*, *touch*, *lasso2*, *ivqte*, and *outreg*. To prevent having any version control issues when reproducing results, the specific version used for each Stata package was saved in the *ado* folder. When running the code, please use the included versions rather than downloading them separately.

Instructions on running the code

Please follow the steps below to successfully reproduce the tables and figures of the paper.

1. Download the datasets used in the paper and save them to the *Raw datasets* folder. Follow the steps for each dataset in the data availability statement of this document.
2. Open the master Do-file (*Master Do-file.do*) in the *Paper 2nd follow-up* folder and set the path where you saved the reproducibility folder in line 37.
3. Run the master Do-file (it should be a one-button run) in Stata. The outputs are saved to four output sub-folders (details on this later) in the *Output* folder.
4. Take the four output subfolders (named *Graph*, *GraphOG*, *Tables*, *TableOT*) and upload them directly (as complete folders) to a new Overleaf session (in a personal Overleaf account you have).
5. Upload the *main.tex* file of the *Overleaf* folder and upload it to the Overleaf session where you uploaded the 4 output subfolders, and compile the file online to get the outputs seen in the publication paper.

The code in more detail

The master do-file does the following process:

- Does the initial set up
 - In line 37: sets the path of the reproducibility folder
 - In line 42: sets the *ado* folder with the Stata packages needed for the code to run.

- Runs the data processing given input raw and anonymized data. For this case, data cleaning and variable creation are both included in *processing do-file.do*.
- Runs *Outputs Restud paper.do*, which covers the tables and figures seen in the publication.

The data processing Do-file

processing do-file.do. cleans and produces variables from the raw datasets. It produces composite databases that contain baseline, midline, and endline variables for estimations.

The analysis Do-file

Outputs Restud paper.do covers the code used for the outputs (tables and figures) used in the publication. It first covers the 10 main tables of the paper¹, then covers all figures, and finally produces the 20 tables of the appendix.

Outputs

The code produces all outputs of the paper, with the following exceptions (figures that do not need reproducibility verification given their nature):

- Figure 1: Experimental design.
- Figure 7: Youth decision to participate in apprenticeship.
- Figure 8: Equilibrium employment of traditional apprentices and tightness.

There are four subfolders of outputs²:

- *Tables*: main tables
- *TableOT*: appendix tables
- *Graph*: main figures
- *GraphOT*: appendix figures

Data availability statement

This publication uses four types of datasets that are publicly available in the World Bank Microdata Library (MDL) and the Enterprise Survey data portal. Below is the information on the name of the datasets, available documentation, and instructions for accessing each.
