Results were reproduced in a computer with the following specifications:

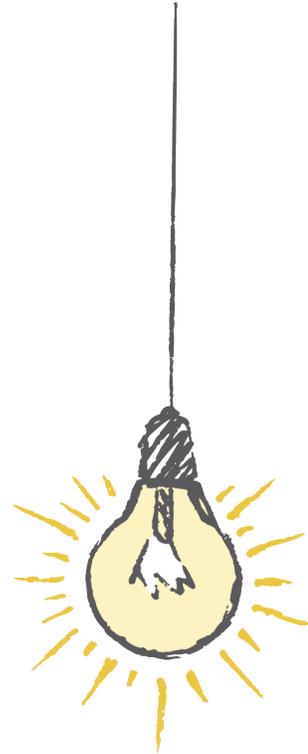
